2025 Ministry Report: A Year of Restoring Hope

We are grateful to share Harvest House’s 2025 Ministry Report—a reflection of God’s faithfulness and the incredible impact made possible through our community of supporters, volunteers, and partners.

This year, Harvest House served 2,743 families, distributed more than 368,000 pounds of food, provided \$110,589 in emergency financial assistance, and helped 3,015 families access clothing and household essentials. Through our programs, 98% of pantry clients reported that Harvest House helped ease their financial stress.

In 2025, we also launched our first Getting Ahead class, a 20-week program designed to help participants build the tools and resources needed for long-term stability. Alongside food, financial aid, and clothing assistance, our life skills classes continue to equip individuals with confidence, independence, and hope.

Behind every number is a story—families finding stability, individuals rediscovering dignity, and neighbors stepping forward to serve one another in love.

This week, Harvest House is approaching **Week 3** of our 20-week **Getting Ahead** class—a small-group program designed to help adults move from crisis toward long-term stability.

Rooted in the *Bridges Out of Poverty* framework, Getting Ahead helps participants understand the hidden barriers that keep families in poverty, build practical resources, and create a personal plan for a more stable future. Each week, participants gather to learn, reflect, and encourage one another as they take courageous steps toward lasting change.
